



The Dr. Thomas D. Wilson Student Assistant Scholarship is a \$1,000 award given out annually to one Milner Library student employee. A 1959 graduate, Dr. Wilson taught politics and government at ISU for more than 30 years. This award, created by Dr. Wilson's wife Kay Wilson, honors his dedication to Milner Library and love of learning.

### **Eligibility**

- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- A sophomore, junior, or senior
- A student employee at Milner Library for at least one semester prior to application
- Cannot have previously received this award

### **Application Submission**

The 2020 application deadline is Friday, October 9 at 5 p.m. Interested student employees must complete and submit the screening application along with all other required materials.
